The site Assistant was Tom Adams. It was demolished c1990.</p> </div> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>General Store c1890 Advertised with the following slogan "Gray's is Great" this general store and grocer was later a Foodland supermarket. The CWA man was based at the rear from 1940. Here, babies were weighed and health checked at the small baby clinic. A youth center also occupied a room. Burned down on Easter Monday 1961.</p> </div> <div style="text-align: center;">  <p>Maguire's Buildings 1936 Jack Maguire sold HV McKay and Massey Harris farm machinery and traded grain from this store. Jack Gray returned from WWII in the Middle East with one leg missing and took over the business. He used to truck produce from Albury to Yerong Creek, cutting groceries and rural supplies for sale at this shop. Typical supplies were stock and poultry feed, machine oil, shearing tools, fencing materials, and groceries. Private property - No public access</p> </div> </div>
